One of the main questions that we pondered is, "What are our retreatants experiencing in their lives as they seek to live out their faith and walk with the Lord day by day?" There is chaos at times, and surely confusion, too. Even the most faithful may cry out, "Lord, where are you?" This question reminds us of the apostles' experience in the boat, as found in the Gospel of Mark 4: 37-40:



"A great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that the boat was already being swamped. But Jesus was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke him up and said to him, 'Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?' He woke up and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, 'Peace! Be still!' Then the wind ceased, and there was a dead calm. He said to them, 'Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?'"

Our retreat theme this year is entitled, "Navigating Turbulent Waters." The emphasis of our retreat will not be the turbulence. Lord knows there is enough of that! But rather, we will take peaceful, quiet time to think about how to "navigate" the rough waters that we see around us, no matter where they may be found. Jesus is with us through it all and for this we rejoice and give thanks. We certainly look forward to welcoming you once again on retreat to St. Paul of the Cross Passionist Retreat Center. God bless you all and all your loved ones. And may the Lord fill your hearts with his peace and joy.


